Rhubarb had been brought to the RSPCA Ashford, Tenterden and District Branch after having been rescued from the side of the M20 by an inspector. Thought to have been thrown from a car Rhubarb was nursed back to health by a dedicated team of volunteers at the Ashford Branch. After two months Rhubarb was happily rehomed with a caring family. Although much of the Branch's work is carried out by dedicated volunteers there is a price tag. It costs the Ashford, Tenterden & District Branch £150,000 a year to care for unwanted and abandoned cats like Rhubarb.
