### WHAT CAN YOU HELP WITH?

Attending our events and open days, helping the event run smoothly and running stalls/ games. Events are usually once a month on Saturdays 11-2. We would Keep your details on a list to contact if needed for events.

Attending a monthly fundraising committee meeting to discuss future fundraising and events. This is usually held on the first Tuesday of the month at 6.30pm.

Setting up and monitoring collection tins at different shops and businesses. You will need to contact and arrange with a business, then collect the tin when full.

Helping to price up items for online fundraising, e.g. researching the value of antiques/ designer brands to be sold on ebay and vinted. This can be any week day for a couple of hours between 11-3, can be flexible.

Helping to run stalls at external events/ holding donation buckets in shops. Your details would be kept on a list, and you would be contacted if needed.

Research new fundraising ideas (themed games for halloween/ christmas events and new fundraising methods) and sharing on our fundraising facebook group. Great if you have new ideas but can't attend the committee meetings.
